MINUTES OF VALLEY COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

The Valley County Board of Equalization met in special session on Monday, July 19, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. to consider a Destroyed Property Report. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call: Cetak, DeRiso, VanSlyke, Cullers, Waldmann present, Baker and Sevenker absent. Clerk verified meeting notice published in the Ord Quiz on June 22, 2022 and posted on the County website, agenda posted. The agenda was adopted on motion of Waldmann, second VanSlyke. Carried. Yes: DeRiso, Cetak, VanSlyke, Cullers, Waldmann. No: none. Absent: Baker and Sevenker. Cullers noted that the Open Meetings Act is posted and public copies are available. No public comment was offered. The Clerk and Assessor were present.
